quickly. The SDS-plus bit system allows for tool-free bit changes with automatic bit locking. The tool has a long power cord with flexible ball grommet that pivots 35° to minimize cord wear and tear.

This versatile hammer lets users get a variety of jobs done, adjusting tool settings based on application and material. It has a no-load rpm at 0-900 for fast drilling and under-load bpm at 0-4,000 for masonry applications. The selector knob makes it easy to switch among drilling only, hammer drilling and chiseling.

The rotary hammer's efficient air-flow design optimizes air circulation for optimal motor cooling.
