Its auto-stop brake features a stroke mechanism that stops immediately after the trigger is moved to the off position for increased user protection, while the LED light and blower function provide an optimal view of the cutting line for precision.

The 18V Barrel-Grip Jig Saw also boasts four pendulum stages so users can choose between fast cutting progress or cleaner cuts, a one-hand, tool-free T-shank blade-change system for easy release of the saw blade and easy blade changes, especially when hot or broken, plus speed preselection to choose the correct blade speed for specific applications.
